

Tanzania 12 days Senior Safaris Day by day Safaris itinerary

DATE	ACCOMODATIONS	ACTIVITIES
Day 01:	Travel to Africa	International flight to Kilimanjaro airport
Day 02:	Arumeru River Lodge Arusha	Arriving at Kilimanjaro Airport. After clearing customs you will be met by our guide and transfer to the lodge. You will have a short briefing to review your Safaris itinerary.
Day 03:	Arumeru River Lodge Arusha National park	Visit Arusha national park- Half day wildlife game viewing and walking safaris in the park. Lunch in the park, later drive back to Arumeru Lodge.
Day 04:	Farm House Lodge Lake Manyara National Park	Pick up from the hotel in Arusha at 0900am and drive on tarmac road 130km with lunch box to Lake Manyara National Park on the base of the Great Rift Valley, for the afternoon game drives. The park is home to tree climbing lions, hippo, elephant, zebra, buffalo, giraffe, baboon, blue and vervet monkey and more. About 350 species of birds have been recorded.
Day 05:	Farm House lodge Ngorongoro Crater	Wake up early morning for breakfast then at 0600hours descend into the crater floor for wildlife viewing. It contains a river, several swamps, a soda lake which is a refuge for flamingo. All the big five (rhino, lion, leopard, buffalo and elephant) live in this wonderful caldera, others are zebra, hippo, wildebeest, hyena and more. Your lunch will be served in the picnic site in the Crater at Ngoitoktok swamp a hippo pool. Dinner and overnight lodge

Day 06-07: Mbugani Tented Camp
Ngorongoro Ndotu area

After breakfast you will drive to Lake Ndotu area, situated in the Ngorongoro conservation area, part of the southern Serengeti- Ngorongoro ecosystem. Although the lake is Alkaline- it's still drinkable and used by a lot of wild animals. In this area, wildebeest migration can normally be found on the short-grass plains from Mid-December to Mid-April.

Day 08: Kati Kati Tented camp
Serengeti National Park

After breakfast drive to the Great Serengeti National Park - with its endless plains, rolling into the distance as far as the eye can see. Game drive at central Serengeti (Seronera area) one of the richest wildlife habitats in the park, featuring the Seronera River, which act as back-born valuable water source to this area and therefore this area is a refugees to many wild animals species in Serengeti.

Day 09: Serengeti Kati Camp
Serengeti National Park

After breakfast, continues with both morning and afternoon game drives in Serengeti national Park. Serengeti is very large and your game drives will depend on the move of the migrants; calving is supposed to be southern Serengeti at this time, your guide knows very well how to locate the herds. You will have all meals in your reserved Serengeti camp.

Day 10: Serengeti Kati Camp
Serengeti National Park

During stay in Serengeti, you can decide with your guide how you would like to spend this day. On most morning you will be awakened earlier and after coffee or tea depart on an early morning game drive. The earlier mornings are magical in Serengeti, when the wildlife is just waking up to greet the day. You will have all meals Kati camp.

Day 11: Ngorongoro farm house
Karatu

Start driving back toward Ngorongoro - Karatu, Then; visit Olduvai Gorge, commonly referred to as the “Cradle of mankind.” where the Leakeys made some of the world’s most important archaeological discoveries, including the remains of several early hominids estimated to be around 3.7 million years old. Oldupai is the Maasai word for the wild sisal plant *Sansevieria ehrenbergii*, which grows in the gorge. Dinner and overnight farm house

Day 12: Transfer to airport
Kilimanjaro International airport
