

## Tanzania 15 days Unique Safaris Day by day Safaris itinerary

<b>DATE</b>	<b>ACCOMODATIONS</b>	<b>ACTIVITIES</b>
Day 01:	Travel to Africa	International flight to Kilimanjaro airport
Day 02:	Kigongoni Arusha	Arriving at Kilimanjaro Airport. After clearing customs you will be met by our guide and transfer to the Hotel. You will have a short briefing to review your Safaris itinerary.
Day 03:	Kigongoni lodge Arusha National Park	Visit Arusha national park- Half day wildlife game viewing and walking safaris in the park. Lunch in the park, later drive back to Kigongoni lodge.
Day 04:	Maromboi Tented Camp Tarangire National Park	Pick up from your lodge in Arusha at 0900am and drive on tarmac road 120km to Tarangire National Park for game drives. Lunch picnic there after lunch continue with afternoon game viewing in the park, identify different species of mammals such as Lion, Leopard, Elephant, buffalo, Python, Zebra, Oryx, Impala and more. Over 450 species of birds have been observed. Dinner and overnight at Dinner and overnight at Maromboi tented camp.
Day 05:	Maromboi Tented Camp Tarangire National Park	After breakfast, enjoy the long morning of game viewing, stopping for picnic lunch. This park is known as the park of Elephants and Baobabs as are scattered everywhere in the park while the Tarangire River is source water to animals in the park. Dinner and overnight as the day before.

Day 06: Ngorongoro Farms House  
Lake Manyara National Park

Breakfast at 0700am. Start your game drive on tarmac road 60km with lunch box to Lake Manyara National Park on the base of the Great Rift Valley, for the Afternoon game drives. Apart from the size of the park which is 205sq miles. The park is one of the beautiful wildlife sanctuary in Tanzania. It's noted for incredible lush ground water forest of mahogany and giant fig trees, which are home of troops of Baboon, and blue monkey. The park is also a home to Lion, Hippo, Elephant, Zebra, Buffalo, Giraffe, Warthog and many more. About 350 species of birds have been recorded. The park is also famous for its large flocks of flamingos. Dinner and overnight at farm house.

Day 07: Ngorongoro Farm House  
Ngorongoro Crater Authority

Wake up early morning for breakfast then at 0700hours descend into the Crater floor for wildlife viewing. It contains a river, several swamps, a soda lake which is a refuge for Flamingo. All the Big five Rhino, Lion, Leopard, Buffalo and Elephant live in this wonderful caldera, others are Zebra, Hippo, Wildebeest, Hyena and more. Your lunch will be served in the picnic site in the Crater at Ngoitoktok swamp or Hippo pool. Dinner and overnight at Ngorongoro farm house.

Day 08: Serengeti Kati Tented Camp  
Serengeti National Park

Today drive to Great Serengeti National park, the world's famous park. Then, visit Olduvai Gorge, commonly referred to as the "Cradle of mankind." Where the Leakeys made some of the world's most important archaeological discoveries, including the remains of several early hominids estimated to be around 3.7 million years old. Oldupai is the Maasai word for the wild sisal plant *Sansevieria ehrenbergii*, which grows in the gorge. En route Serengeti Park for Game drive. Dinner and overnight Serengeti Kati.

Day 09: Serengeti Kati Tented Camp  
Serengeti National Park

After breakfast, continues with both morning and afternoon game drives in Serengeti national Park. Serengeti is very large and your game drives will depend on the move of the migrants; your guide knows very well how to locate the herds. You will have all meals in your reserved Serengeti kati

Day 10: Serengeti Kati Tented Camp  
Serengeti National Park

During stay in Serengeti, you can decide with your guide how you would like to spend this day. On most morning you will be awakened earlier and after coffee or tea depart on an early morning game drive. The earlier mornings are magical in Serengeti, when the wildlife is just waking up to greet the day. You will have all meals in Serengeti Kati.

Day 11: Ngorongoro Farm House  
Karatu

This morning after breakfast it's time to depart the Serengeti to Karatu. The drive should take about approximately 4 hours. Dinner and overnight at Karatu farms house.

Day 12: Tindiga Tented Camp  
Lake Eyasi

In the morning at 0830hrs pick up from your lodge and drive to Lake Eyasi via Karatu arriving there in the early afternoon. After picnic lunch, thorough explanation of the Eyasi and launch a walking trip around the Lake, the breeding site of flamingo bird. Dinner and Overnight at Tindiga Tented Camp

Day 13: Tindiga Tented Camp  
Bushmen experience

After breakfast walk through the scattered bush to the Bushmen's bush-home accompanied by your guide and a local guide who can speak the Bushmen's language. The Bushmen or the Hadzabe tribe lives in groups divided in approx. 10 families, they like visitors. You will experience their bush life as they have unique style of hunting as they eat game meat, rodents, insects, roots and leave. They sleep in caves, shades fearing not of any wild animals, you will have picnic lunch before you walk back to your tented Camp for Dinner and Overnight

Day 14: Eyasi/ Kilimanjaro airport

Breakfast at the Tented camp. Begin your journey back to Arusha. Arrive in Arusha in the earlier afternoon for lunch. Shopping for craft items of sightseeing in Arusha. Check in for day room, afternoon for packing showering and relaxing and earlier dinner at Kia lodge. Pickup for transport to your international flight at Kilimanjaro airport.

Day 15: Travel back home
